## Match Procedures

### Match Start

- Match begins at the time posted on our website and Facebook page.
- Phone calls for confirmation are also accepted.

### Target Assignments

- You may choose your shooting partners and target (minimum 3 shooters per target).
- Groups may be adjusted by the match director depending on attendance.

### Safety Meeting

- A brief safety meeting will precede the match, covering rules and allowing questions.

### Match Format

- Shooter rotation is determined by drawing chips from a bag.
- When ready, the director will ask: "Shooters ready on the right? Ready on the left?"
- Then: "Insert bolts — Relay #1 sighters begin now!" (4 minutes, countdown begins at 45 seconds).
- Director will call: "Clear targets and set for record."
- Then: "Relay #1 record target begins now!" (10 minutes for 10 scored rounds).
- Shooters must remove bolts (or insert chamber flags for semiautos) after shooting.
- This allows the match director to clearly see when all shooters have finished. If everyone is done before the 10-minute timer expires, the string will end early.
- Same process repeats for Relay #2 and any additional relays as needed.
- This completes the first string. The entire process repeats for the second string.

### Shooter Rules

- Bolts must remain out of the rifle until sighter rounds begin.
- Bolts may remain in place between sighter and record rounds.
- Bolts must be removed once record round is complete.
- If a target has fewer shooters, each will draw a chip to determine relay.
- Example: If two shooters draw Relay 1 and 3, no one will shoot in Relay 2.
- Shooting between the sighter and record round (after 'Cease Fire') is a DQ.
